The Doors Of the Examination Hall will be opened on the morning of the first day , one hour before and in the afternoon and on the others Days, 15 minutes earlier than the time appointed for this commencement of the examination. In no case a candidate shall be admitted or given a question paper more than 15 minutes after the examination has commenced.
