

GUIDELINES FRAMED BY SUPREME COURT OF INDIA

(INTERIM REPORT)

1. Full time and regular students only can take part in the election.
2. For College Union Elections the age of the candidate should not exceed 24yrs.(Item 17.i)
3. Disassociation of student Elections and student representation from political parties.
4. During the period of elections no person, who is not a student on the rolls of the college, shall be permitted to take part in the election process in any capacity. Any person, candidate or member of the student organization, violating this rule shall be subject to disciplinary proceedings, in addition to the candidature, as the case may be, being revoked.
5. No irregular or private students can participate or be proposer/supporter or participate in campaigning for any candidate.
6. The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office bearer.
7. No arrangement of any form of parties/tea party should be made by contesting candidates.
8. Vehicles or printed banners, posters or any other materials are strictly prohibited.
9. Involvement in civil suit or morally degraded students cannot participate in election.
10. No employees can participate in election campaigning except in conducting the election and other cooperation in official matters.
11. No candidate should be involved in character assassination or exploit religion or culture of other candidates.
12. Candidate must attach H.S.L.C certificate for age verification.
13. Violation of these rules will lead to punishment as indicated in the interim report.
14. The candidates should in no event have academic arrears (No back in exams). Class attendance of the candidate must be above 75% in both major and minor subject individually.
15. Proposer and supporter of the candidate must enclose their admission receipt of the respective semester.
16. A proposer/supporter can propose/support for one candidate only.
17. Only open campaign will be allowed on allotted date & time.
18. Candidates having any complaint against him/her will be debarred from the contest.
19. **Candidates have to submit the Google Form** (Link will be given in the nomination paper).
Submission of both offline and online copies are mandatory.
